Our Products



Global Volunteer (GV) is a project which aims to develop youth leadership through a volunteering project while contributing to the Sustainable Development Goals of the UN. Youth are encouraged to step out of their comfort zone and live in a challenging environment which will develop their leadership competencies, personal skills and improve their language capabilities.

Why AIESEC and Aurora should collaborate?

- We have the same vision and mission. On one hand, Aurora is a socially inclusive network that helps students to take part into a fulfilling experience. On the other hand, AIESEC aims to help the youth to develop both their professional and personal skills. Thanks to both entities, participants will get the opportunity to become a better version of themselves and to have a positive impact in the long run.
- We both operate at the international scale (AIESEC is present in every European country that the Aurora Alliance project is covering). Our aim is to reinforce the cohesion between nations.
- Exchange students and AIESEC candidates are eligible for an Erasmus+ grant. Everyone should get a chance to participate in a fulfilling and once in a lifetime experience.
- We are aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals from the United Nations Development Program. Both of us aim to ensure inclusive quality education and to promote lifelong learning opportunities for all.
- Even though the Aurora Alliance project was formed in 2016 while AIESEC was created in 1948, both have a common historical context. 2020 has been an intense year due to the covid-19 pandemic, and it is more necessary than ever to provide the youth with a strong education and opportunities abroad once the storm will be over.



Practicalities of collaboration

- Before students go abroad, the local AIESEC entity and the university discuss which of our current projects align with the four Aurora Pillars and the desired competencies development and write a target competencies/learning outcome for the opportunities which are aligned.
- Students who are interested in going abroad, can sign up on the AIESEC website.
- AIESEC guides them in choosing a project that is aligned with the Aurora Pillars and the desired competencies development.
- Once a project is chosen, students apply for the opportunity.
- If students are accepted, AIESEC will provide help in the preparation process, to ensure they go abroad with the right mindset.
- While being on the project abroad, the accommodation will be provided by AIESEC and the student will be coached throughout its stay to help the competencies/learning outcomes to be reached.
- When students arrive back home, AIESEC will guide them in their reflection on the journey, to help all learning outcomes to stay at the student as long as possible.
